This past year, our focus was on revamping our programs to better cater to our families and provide the necessary resources for success. Families face many challenges, and we remain true to our mission with programs aimed at serving children and families, closing the learning gap, and keeping children engaged in activities.

Our efforts to meet these challenges include school-year programming, summer programs, and community events. Our school-year programming features before and after-school STEM-based learning and availability during academic vacation times. ERfC's summer programming, Summer Escape, includes robust hands-on activities such as art, wellness, sports, and robotics, along with a free summer lunch program that serves 2,800 students in the Enfield area. Our community events range from movie nights and ice cream socials to our annual backpack and school supply drive, which serves more than 1,300 students in the Enfield area.

2,800

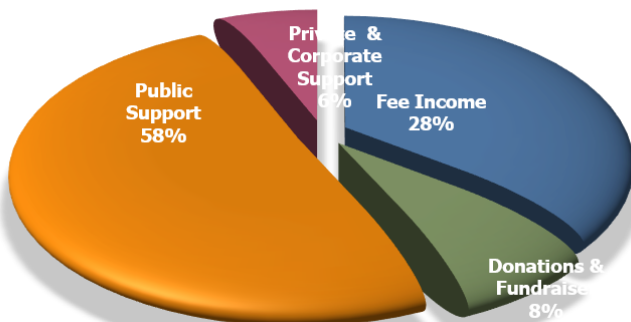
2,800 free USDA lunches were provided to children from two locations in July and August.

Middle School Program

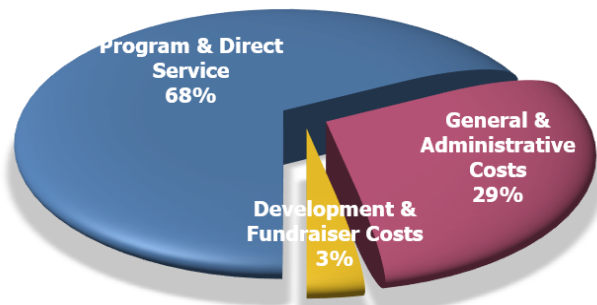
37

37 middle schoolers in grades 6-8 enrolled in our fully funded teen program.

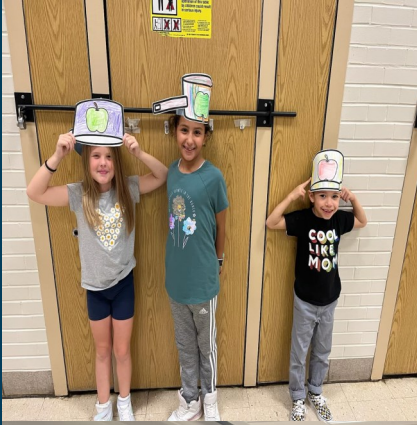
ERfC Income: FY 2023-2024

ERfC Programs

- Before School Centers** **Grades K-5.** Before School programs are located in all Enfield Elementary Schools and run from 7 AM to start of the school day. Students start their days with a snack and guided enrichment activities.
- After School Centers** **Grades K-8.** After School programs are located in all Enfield Primary Schools and JFK Middle School. Students in grades 3-5 are bused from their secondary school to their respective primary school after school. All After School Centers run from the end of the school day until 6 PM. Students enjoy a snack, receive homework assistance, and participate in fun enrichment activities.
- Academic Vacations** **Grades K-8.** ERfC Vacation Days are held at Enfield Street School from 8 AM to 6 PM on specific school vacation days for children. Each day will include a breakfast snack and an afternoon snack. We will play games, have activities indoors or outside, STEAM activities, and much more.
- Intern/CIT Program** **Grades 10-12 & College.** Since 2021 ERfC continues to strengthen our postsecondary partnerships by offering work experience internships. College level interns acquire knowledge and gain valuable hands-on experience while fulfilling educational program requirements. Our interns bring ideas and knowledge from school into our programs to help children achieve their academic goals while contributing to the community. Our Counselor-in-Training program offers teenagers in grades 10 to 12 the opportunity to make a difference in our community, while developing leadership skills and learning to become an impactful counselor and role model to young campers.
- Summer Escape Camp** **Grades K-8.** ERfC Summer Escape Camp is held each Summer for K-8 students in and around Enfield. Camp is open daily from June through August, Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Extended day hours are available beginning at 7:00 AM to the start of camp and the end of camp until 6:00 PM.
- Community Programs** **Everyone.** ERfC is proud to celebrate our 30-year anniversary supporting families and collaborating with community organizations. We offer many free events to our community, including Family Fun Nights, Math Nights, Ice Cream Socials, the Backpack & School Supply Drive, PTO collaborations, and more! Through our collaborations, we help many children learn and reach their goals!
